Required courses (6):

HIST 7908: Introduction to Historical Research (3 hrs)

HIST 7909: Research Seminar in European History (3 hrs)

HIST 7915 - 7930 (12 hrs; 4 courses total) **

** Students concentrating in Europe to 1650 may substitute one HIST 7915-7930 with a 4000-level HIST course

Required: 24 hours of coursework and at least 6 hours of thesis research

Half the coursework hours must be at or above the 7000 level.

Graduate students may also take 4000-level courses with a member of the graduate faculty who will assign additional work to earn graduate-level credit.

Students may take 7902, Independent Study, no more than twice for a total of 6 credit hours.
